

## **About Waushara County EMS**

Welcome to beautiful Waushara County, Wisconsin!

Waushara County EMS headquarters is located in Wautoma with Ambulance Stations in Poy Sippi, Plainfield and Coloma. Waushara County EMS consists of a mix of full and part-time staff. We have four ambulances and one Paramedic intercept that are staffed twenty four hours a day, seven days a week, as well as one reserve ambulance and intercept unit that is staffed on an as needed basis. We cover most of Waushara County as well as parts of Marquette and Adams Counties. Our coverage area is over 700 square miles. We respond to both 911 emergency calls and inter-facility transfers.

We also administrate the following programs: Project Lifesaver, Public Access AEDs and Child Alert. We annually respond to approx. 3,000 calls. We have three full-time administrative personnel as well as twelve full-time field personnel and thirty eight part-time personnel. We employ EMT -Basics, EMT -Intermediate Technicians and EMT - Paramedics.
