The parks are open year round, except for Mt. Morris which is open from April until November. Tables and grills are available for use throughout all of the parks.

Shelter reservations can be made by calling the Parks Department at 920-787-7037. Please allow at least two weeks notice prior to your event. There is a \$25 fee for shelter reservations. Office hours are Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday and hours vary as follows:

- ◆ November–March: 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.
- ◆ April–May: 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.
- ◆ June–August: 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.
- ◆ September–October: 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Reservations are required for the shelters located at Lake Alpine, Kusel Lake Upper Shelter, Mt. Morris Hills, Otto Brey, and Pony Creek. All other shelters are used on a first-come first-serve basis. The Parks Department will begin taking shelter reservations the first work day after January 1 for the new year.

Shooting range hours are 8 a.m. to 7 p.m.; **DAYLIGHT HOURS ONLY**; from April through November.
