Copies of records, which may be released pursuant to Chapter 19 of the Wisconsin Statutes or other laws, are available through oral or written requests (District Attorney/Corporation Counsel's option) during regular office hours, 8:00AM to 4:30PM, Monday through Fridays, legal holidays excepted. The cost of a copy is twenty cents (\$.20) per page, up to 8.5"x14" page size.
