The Waushara County Sheriff's Department is releasing the following information pursuant to the Wisconsin State Statute 301.45 and 301.46 (Act 440), which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender's release when, in the discretion of the agency, the release of information will enhance public safety and protection.

The individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense that requires registration with local law enforcement agencies. Further, this individual's previous criminal history places him in a classification level which reflects the potential to reoffend.

This sex offender has served the sentence imposed on him by the courts and has relocated to Waushara County. This person is NOT wanted by the police at this time. This notification is not intended to increase fear; rather, it is our belief that an informed public is a safer public.

Sex offenders have always lived in our communities, but it was not until passage of Act 440 that law enforcement even knew where they were living. In many cases, law enforcement is now able to share that information with the public. Citizen abuse of this information to threaten, intimidate or harass registered sex offenders will NOT be tolerated.

Lloyd R. Pitzen was released from jail on December 16, 2010 after serving a revocation of his sentence for 2nd Degree Sexual Assault.

Pitzen must comply with the following rules:

- Register with the Sex Offender Registry Program.
- Must comply with Sex Offender Registry Program requirements.

Pitzen will be residing on Bighorn Ct. in the Town of Mt Morris.
